Arctic Ocean from the jaw-bone of a whale and a walrus tusk in 1835. Presented by him to Noah Shumway at Oxford, Mass., 1840. Descended to J. Shumway, Caledonia, Minn., 1857. Given by him to H.P. Shumway, Lyons Nebr., 1915. Nathan Paine was a great-uncle of Senator Shumway on his mother's side. The cane may be seen in the window of the Wakefield, [NE] postoffice. '
