GAR Veteran Dies, H E Eustis, Brother of Mace Eustis, Had Lived in Minneapolis Since 1863

Humphrey E Eustis, who had been in the transfer business in Minneapolis for the last 25 years, died Tuesday at 18 Thirteenth St north. He came to Minneapolis in 1863, went from here to Moorhead for a few years, and returned to go into business in 1881. Mr. Eustis was a member of the Sixteenth Maine Regiment in the Civil War and belonged to Rawlins Post, G.A.R. He has been ill for the past six months.

Mr Eustis was 74 years old. He was a brother of the late Mace Eustis, formerly sheriff of Hennepin County, and two brothers and a sister in the East survive, Mrs Carrie Greenleaf and William T Eustis of Dixfield, Me., and Albert Eustis of Cambridge, Mass. Mrs A Q Fisher, 631 Fourteenth Street East, was his only relative in Minneapolis.
