Sumner Henry Everett 1862-1903

Sumner Henry Everett was born in Alamakee county, Iowa, July 15, 1862, and died at his home near Seiling, Oklahoma, July 15, 1903. His death was due to a stroke of paralysis. He died on the 41st anniversary of his birth. He immigrated with his father, Josiah Everett, and family to Burt county, Neb., in May, 1866. He continued to make his home here until March, 1898, when he removed to Oklahoma. He was united in marriage with Miss Lillie Kelley of this place in 1886.
